Class 1 is restricted to those combinations of horse and rider who have not been placed 1st more than twice in this season at this level or lower. This is carried out on an honesty basis.

Class 3 and 5 are now a pick a test class. Placing will be made on the %. Please state on your entry form which test you wish to ride for these classes.

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place with juniors and seniors placed separately, where there are 10 or more entrants in each section. If there are less than 10 entrants' rosettes will be at secretaries' discretion.

Members of the riding club will accumulate points, when placed, throughout the season for the perpetual challenge trophies which are awarded at the first show of each season for the previous year.

Rules

1. All competitions are run under BD guidelines.
2. Entries in advance only. Late entries will incur a late entry fee.
3. Times can be collected by calling 01603 721794 on the Friday prior to each show between 7pm and 8.30pm.
4. All changes and substitutions must be notified to the secretary and are at the secretary's discretion.
5. All persons entering the showground do so at their own risk. All competitors take part at their own risk. Ferry Farm Riding Club and Ferry Farm Livery Yard take no responsibility for accidents, damage or theft on its premises.
6. To ensure fair and equal competition all riders must take into account their experience when deciding whether they and their horse are entered at the correct level.
7. Affiliated combinations may enter but are asked not to compete below their current affiliated level.
8. All horses to be four years old and over.
9. Riders must be correctly attired and wear a correctly secured hat at all times whilst mounted.
10. Snaffle bits with plain or flash nose band only. No bit guards. No martingales. No boots/bandages.
11. All dogs must be kept on leads.
12. The judges' decision is final.
