9.30am start

Class 1 – Mixed Height Ridden Show Hunter Ponies

Show hunter pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms.

Riders must be correct age and height for the animal they ride

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 18th – 21st August 2011

Class 2 – Novice Ridden Hunter

Exceeding 148cm. Rider any age. Not to have been placed in any ridden hunter class.

Class 3 – Small Ridden Hunter

Open small hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 158cm. Rider any age.

Open ridden hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Rider any age

Middleweight hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not over 14 stone.

Heavyweight hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, capable of carrying over 14 stone.

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms.
Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms.
Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 8 – Working Mountain and Moorland

May split into small breeds and large breeds if entries warrant. Will be required to jump a course of fences not exceeding 0.70m.

First ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Hospitalisation – stable facilities for overnight stays or longer.

Padded operating room - for surgery requiring general anaesthetic and post-op recovery.

Technical equipment – x-ray, ultrasound scanners, endoscope.

Service offered include:-Vaccinations, parasitology, colic assessment and treatment, general surgery, dentistry, lameness investigation, respiratory endoscopy and treatment, cardiac, neurological and liver investigation.

Rules and Regulations of Entry.

1. All ridden horses must be 4 years old and over.
2. Stallions and colts may not be led by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan 2010, and must be indicated by a blue ribbon in the tail or stallion disc.
3. All riders must be properly attired in a correctly secured safety helmet to EN1384, ASTM F1163 or PAS015 or higher standard at all times whilst mounted.
4. The judges reserve the right to ask any competitor to leave the show ring if, in the judges' opinion, the horse is causing a danger or the rider is inappropriately mounted.
5. The judge's decision is final. Objections must be lodged (together with the sum of £25) on the day of the competition, at the secretary's office.
6. Abuse of the judge or steward, either verbal or physical, will not be tolerated and will result in the persons being removed from the showground.
7. The working in of horses may only take place in the designated areas, not in the car or lorry parks.
8. Entry fees are non-refundable/transferable unless a veterinary certificate is produced.
9. Anybody deemed to be mistreating or abusing a horse will be asked to leave the showground.
10. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
11. Horse boxes and trailers must not be mucked out onto the showground and all other litter must be taken home or placed in the bins provided.
12. If entries are low some classes may be combined. The show committee reserve the right to limit the number of prizes awarded in any class at their discretion.
